As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, our mission is to provide a safe haven for local youth through programs funded by community contributions. We bridge a critical gap for vulnerable young people by providing positive role models and fostering constructive relationships between the youth and law enforcement.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

1. How does your proposed project address the LETf Category (see above) as well as the Hollywood Police Department's Priority Area?

Hollywood PAL provides a secure, substance free environment designed to foster positive relationship; building between local youth and law enforcement. By offering a diverse curriculum of physical fitness programs; including soccer, boxing, cheerleading, weight training, basketball, and youth football; we engage participants in constructive alternatives to "street influences." Our programming is strategically structured to instill core values of teamwork and self-confidence, directly addressing community safety and youth development priorities.

2. **Why is this funding needed (What community problem does it address)? What data suggests this program should be implemented with this population or in this geographical location?**

Funding is critical to address the lack of accessible, low-cost youth programming in the City of Hollywood, particularly in neighborhoods where juvenile delinquency and exposure to substance abuse are prevalent. Many local youth lack a safe environment during the high-risk after-school hours (3:00pm – 8:00pm), leaving them vulnerable to "street influences". Without affordable athletic outlets and programs, these children face higher risks of sedentary lifestyles and unsupervised time that often leads to negative interactions with the justice system.

Hollywood PAL provides a holistic youth development platform centered on three core pillars: athletic engagement, academic support, and leadership mentorship. Our services range from competitive sports like tackle football, cheerleading, boxing, and girls flag football, which promote physical fitness and teamwork to youth tutoring and the Police Explorer Program for career exploration. By pairing these activities with dedicated mentoring, we offer a comprehensive support system that empowers local youth to achieve personal and academic excellence.

The Hollywood Police Athletic League operates as a year-round, high-impact youth intervention program, strategically staffed by two Hollywood Police Officers who provide continuous mentorship and oversight. During the summer, the program's capacity expands as School Resource Officers facilitate specialized G.R.E.A.T. (Gang Resistance Education and Training) and Police Explorer camps at our facility, serving a vital population of underserved local youth. This funding is critical for sustaining daily operations, procuring essential athletic equipment, and maintaining a secure, substance-free environment that has historically succeeded in reducing juvenile delinquency. By offering accessible academic support, physical wellness, and constructive alternatives to street influences, PAL bridges the gap between law enforcement and at-risk populations, delivering a measurable and lasting positive impact on the Hollywood community.

5. Describe the Applicant Agency's experience in serving the target population and the capacity of the Applicant Agency to undertake the proposed program.

With over three decades of service, the Hollywood Police Athletic League possesses extensive experience in designing and executing high-impact programs for youth aged 5 to 18. Our organization serves as a cornerstone of the Hollywood community, specializing in the complex needs of at-risk populations. By fostering direct, positive mentorship between law enforcement officers and local youth, we have built a long-standing foundation of trust and mutual understanding that is unique to our institutional model.

Hollywood PAL's operational capacity is reinforced by a proven track record of regional collaboration. While our primary focus remains on Hollywood's urban core, we maintain the capacity to extend our services to youth from the neighboring City of Dania Beach, ensuring a wider geographic impact.

The Hollywood Police Athletic League has a long-standing history of successful stewardship of Hollywood Police Department Law Enforcement Trust Fund resources, receiving consistent support. We are currently requesting an increase in funding to accommodate a significant expansion of our services, driven by a steady rise in youth membership over the past eight years and the critical need to fill the gap left by declining athletic programs in surrounding areas. The funds will be effectively utilized to prevent local youth from entering at-risk categories; by integrating more participants into our structured, officer-led programs.

The Police Athletic League of Hollywood, Inc. requests funding to sustain and expand our comprehensive youth development programming at our facility. Currently serving over 800 active youth members, our 2026-2027 operating budget is designed to maintain a high-quality, safe, and drug-free environment through the following primary expenditure categories:

- **Athletic Program Operations:** Funding will support the logistics of our 60-team 7v7 football league and our amateur boxing program under Coach Antonio Betancourt. This includes official fees, league insurance, and tournament registration costs to ensure these activities remain accessible to at-risk youth at little to no cost.
- **Equipment & Facility Maintenance:** To keep our boxing gym, weight training section, and new mini-pitch soccer system in peak condition, the budget accounts for the replacement of worn safety gear (gloves, pads, helmets) and the upkeep of specialized athletic surfaces and classroom technology.
- **Educational & Summer Programming:** A portion of the budget is allocated to classroom materials for youth tutoring and curriculum-based initiatives like the G.R.E.A.T. and Police Explorer summer camps. This ensures we can provide academic enrichment alongside physical fitness.
- **Administrative Oversight:** Under the leadership of Executive Director Major Thea Basler and our Executive Board, funds will be utilized for essential operational costs, including insurance, background checks for volunteers, and facility utilities, ensuring a secure and professionally managed environment.

The requested financial support is pivotal to bridging the gap between current operational costs and our mission to provide quality mentorship. By investing in this budget, you will facilitates the positive interactions between Hollywood Police Officers and the community's youth, fostering stronger community ties and empowering the next generation of productive citizens.

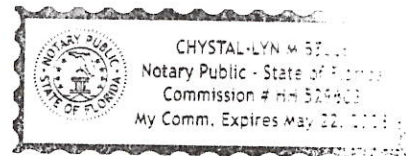

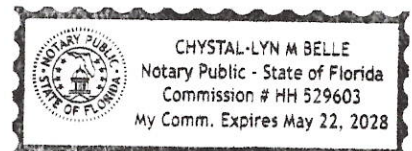
