A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT WITH BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF BROWARD COUNTY, INC. FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE MARTI HUIZENGA BOYS & GIRLS CLUB TO INCLUDE A TEEN CENTER, INCREASING FUNDING BY \$300,000.00 FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$550,000.00, AND EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2027.

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-2024-251, approving the Five-Year Consolidated Plan for Federal Program Years 2024/2025-2028/2029, along with the Annual Action Plan and Projected Use of Funds for Federal Program Year 2024/2025, which identifies eligible activities under the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) program, including Public Facilities and Infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2024, the City entered into an Agreement with the Boys and Girls Club of Broward County, Inc. (“BGCBC”), a Florida not-for-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 for the renovation and expansion of the Marti Huizenga Boys & Girls Club, including the development of a teen center located at 1111 North 69<sup>th</sup> Way in the Boulevard Heights Neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, BGCBC’s mission is to enable young people to reach their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible citizens; and

WHEREAS, BGCBC has long served as an invaluable resource to the City’s youth by providing a safe, supportive, and welcoming learning environment; and

WHEREAS, applications for CDBG funding were accepted from January 6, 2026, through February 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, BGCBC submitted an application requesting additional funding to complete expanded renovation activities necessary for the full development of the teen center; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, the Community Development Advisory Board reviewed the funding request and recommended approval of an increase in funding and an extension of the agreement term to ensure successful completion of the project and maximize community benefit; and

WHEREAS, following discussions with the Executive Director and a review of project data and funding needs, City staff determined that an additional allocation of \$300,000, for a total CDBG investment of \$550,000, represents the most practical and appropriate funding level for the project; and

WHEREAS, the BGCBC is a non-profit public service agency and is eligible to receive CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, funding for the public facilities project is available in the FY 2026 operating budget in account numbers; 115.160101.55400.584650.001002.000.000, 115.160101.55400.591340.001544.000.000, 115.160101.55400.591340.001706.000.000, 115.160101.55400.584380.001863.000.000, and 115.160101.55400.584380.001963.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached First Amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Agreement with BGCBC, increasing the total funding by \$300,000 for a revised total amount not to exceed \$550,000, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That it further approves the extension of the term of the Agreement through November 30, 2027, to allow for completion of the renovation and expansion of the teen center.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
